Remark :

1. Minimum of at least 24 credits for graduation (Does not include “Thesis Seminar” and “Special Topic”). At most admit elective courses outside the school and the outer court 6 credits. Graduate students should practice “Special Topic” 2 semesters.
2. Graduate students must pass the Graduation Thesis. Graduation Thesis for the academic research papers or practical technical papers; practice technical papers including design papers and planning papers.
3. Before the Oral Examination of Graduation Thesis, student must have completed the “Ethics Education” courses. The courses are to be completed by visiting the “Research Ethics Education” website, pass the online exam and obtain the certificate.
4. Before graduation, the results of the dissertation should be published in at least one domestic and international academic seminar or at least once in the national and international competitions.
